Current protection – Orphan and Custody courts


- Social care -> municipality function
- 119 local municipalities, 132 Orphan and custody courts (139 in 2016)
- Settles disagreements (parents, parents <-> children, parents <-> guardians)
- Determines guardians for unaccompanied children on move
- Best interests determination -> Custody institutions

Issues

- De-centralized system
- Tax income differences
- Qualification of employees
- Boarding schools as outfamily care institutions
- Best interests determination procedure – not clearly defined





Training

 46% of custody institutions – no formal training on human trafficking (end of 2016 data)

- Ombudsman campaigns against placing children in institutional care;

- More monitoring activities
